

- 2. Peter uses three words in verse 4 to contrast our inheritance with all other goals, desires, or treasures. Think about what you desire or treasure. Which of these things will perish, spoil or fade?
- 3. Is your relationship with the Lord and the salvation that He has provided truly the greatest thing in your life? Why or why not?
- 4. Even the most severe trials in our lives reflect God's eternal purposes and His loving pursuit of us. If we held fast to this truth, how might it change the way we think about these trials and difficulties?
- 5. How could you and others support one another if/when someone is struggling with their faith?
