1. What does it mean to you that everything was made *for* Jesus? What does this imply about what the world was meant to be like?
2. Among the entities created by and for Jesus were “thrones, dominions, rulers, [and] powers” (v.16); what does this say about Jesus’ authority and Lordship?
3. In what way was Jesus the “firstborn from the dead” (v.18)? Who will follow Jesus in being “born” from the dead? What Christian hope is this phrase referring to?
4. Describe in your own words what the phrase “fullness of God” (v.19) means. What does it mean that this fullness dwells in Jesus?
5. What is God planning to reconcile to Himself through Jesus? What do you imagine the world will be like once God has accomplished this goal?
